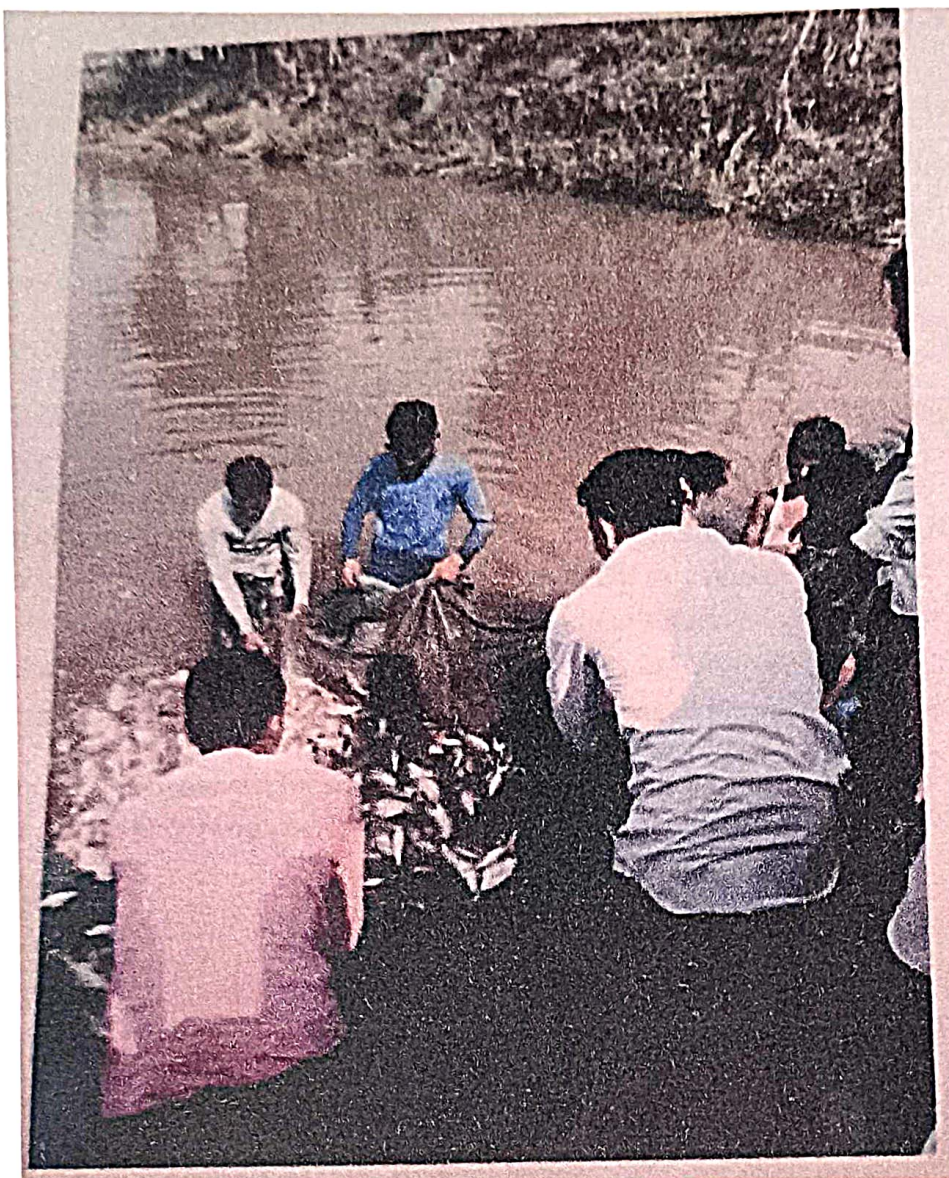
Visit to a fish farm of Kathaldi Part I is organised by the department of Zoology in Collaboration with IQAC Bilasipara College
