

## **Model Code of Conduct (M.C.C.)**

To ensure free, fair and transparent Election, the following model codes of conduct are to be followed by the candidates and their supporters during College Election as per the provisions of the BCSU Constitution:

- 1. Fair Campaigning: Candidates must avoid personal attacks, defamation, or false accusations against opponents. Campaigning should focus on issues and solutions.
- 2. No Influence or Bribery: Offering money, gifts, or other incentives to gain votes is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Respect for Rules: All candidates and supporters must adhere to the guidelines set by the College Election Commission.
- 4. Non-Disruptive Activities: Campaign activities should not disrupt academic schedules, campus harmony, or public spaces.
- 5. No Use of Coercion: Candidates must ensure that no form of coercion, including threats or peer pressure, is used to gain votes.
- 6. Ethical Conduct: Posters, banners, and campaign material should avoid offensive or discriminatory language. Avoid damaging College property or defacing College infrastructure.
- 7. Respect Voting Privacy: The voting process should be free from undue influence and privacy of votes must be maintained.
- 8. Dispute Resolution: Any disputes should be addressed through the Election Commission to avoid any sorts of students' unrest or unwanted controversies.
